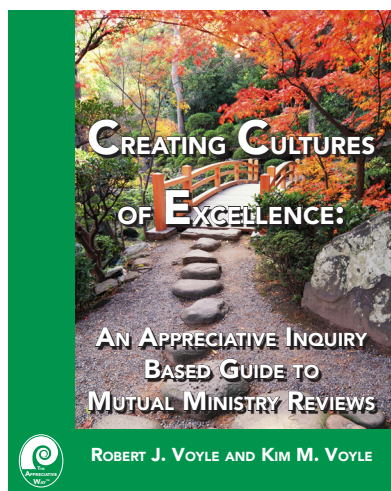

THE APPRECIATIVE WAY OF LEADING TRANSFORMATION

*"Jesus didn't come that we might have less death,
he came that we might have life."*

Too often we spend our time engaged in change processes that, at best, are stop-gap measures to delay death. What the church needs today is not change but transformation — a new way of seeing and being in the world.

The **Appreciative Way** is an intentional, strategic way of engaging in transformation by discovering and growing what is life-giving to individuals and congregations. The **Appreciative Way** is Rob Voyle's synthesis of the change strategies of; **Appreciative Inquiry**, the change work of **Milton Erickson** and his students, and **Contemplative Spirituality**. In this 5 day (30hrs. CE) you will learn the **Appreciative Way** of:

- ◆ Living with Purpose and Vision.
- ◆ Conducting an appreciative inquiry into your vocation and mission.
- ◆ Discovering and Growing what is Life-Giving.
- ◆ Using the Three Faces of Compassion:
Tenderness, Fierceness, and Mischievousness to transform the world.

We will then apply it to congregations in transition and congregation Development to:

- ◆ Learn the incarnational way of joining a congregation.
- ◆ Establish goals for congregations in transition and transformation.
- ◆ Respond appreciatively to congregational dynamics of grief and conflict.
- ◆ Plan and design an appreciative inquiry summit.
